He drafts and negotiates contracts on behalf of his business clients, and serves as general counsel for several non-profits. Earlier in his career, he was a plaintiff's attorney specializing in personal injury and wrongful death litigation.

A stand-up comedian in college, Mr. Richardson is a frequent keynote speaker, media contributor, and seminar panel participant and moderator. He presents to employers on the legal and ethical responsibilities of individuals and companies; in college/university environments on the ramifications of greek hazing; and in community settings on how law imitates life. He has also taught California Civil Procedure as an adjunct professor at the University of LaVerne College of Law.
